



Uniform Policy

Rationale

At Lakeview Senior College we pride ourselves in making choices that reflect our school values of respect, responsibility and personal achievement at all times. Our school uniform is important because it symbolises these values and promotes them throughout our community.

Implementation

The dress code will:

- be developed in consultation with students, parents and the College Council.
- allow students to safely engage in the variety of college activities.
- recognise the financial implications for families.
- be published on the College website.
- be managed and consistent with the Student Code of Conduct, DET guidelines and with the co-operation of parents.
- allow for parents to apply for exemptions due to cultural beliefs, health condition or financial hardship.

Goals and purpose

- To create a sense of collective and individual pride in the students and their identification with the College.
- Dress competition between students is eliminated, thus ensuring greater equality among students.
- All students are required to be in full uniform during the school day, including travelling to and from school and on excursions.

If a student is unable to attend the College in full school uniform, a note explaining the reason and duration must be given to the Co-ordinator before school. A sanction for non-compliance by a student **may include a parent/ guardian contact, redemption of time, and if the dress code is continually breached, removal from class, sent home and/or suspension.**

General appearance

- T-shirts, skivvies and singlets must not be visible under school uniform
- Undershirts are to be white without visible markings
- Students may be asked to remove jewellery that poses an OH&S risk
- Shirts fully buttoned
- Skirts and dresses are to be of appropriate length
- Sports uniforms are only for PE/sport classes and activities
- Beanies and caps need to be plain black or white and worn outdoors only
- Uniform items cannot be modified in anyway, with the exception of alterations for sizing

School shoes

Doc Martin boots/8 ups are not acceptable as school shoes although plain black Doc Martin shoes may be worn. Vans and Converse footwear of any kind are also not acceptable as school shoes at Lakeview Senior College. School shoes should have a distinct heel and are not made of canvas.

Non-uniform items

Hoodies, non-school coloured beanies, leggings and jeans are not items of College uniform and therefore are not permitted to be worn on school grounds. Students wearing a hoodie on school grounds will be required to remove the garment immediately.

Out of uniform days

Out of uniform days are sometimes held in order to raise money for social services/charities. On such occasions, neat casual dress and safe footwear is permitted. The Principal reserves the right to decide what is permissible. Information regarding appropriate dress and footwear for each out-of-uniform day will be communicated to students via the College daily bulletin and the College Website if required.

* Sports Uniform can be worn to school if participating in Interschool sport.

Year 12 College Jacket: Students enrolled in year 12 at Lakeview Senior College will be provided with the opportunity to purchase a College issued Year 12 Jacket. The Year 12 College Jacket is considered a College uniform item and as such the jacket must not be modified in any manner. Year 12 students are only permitted to wear the jacket applicable to the year in which they are enrolled.

School shoes

What are acceptable school shoes?

Doc Martin boots/8 ups are not acceptable as school shoes although plain black Doc Martin shoes may be worn. Vans and Converse footwear of any kind are also not acceptable as school shoes at Lakeview Senior College. School shoes should have a distinct heel and are not made of canvas.
